Description: On March 26, 2023 Officer Hermansen was involved in a single car motor vehicle crash with her police vehicle. Officer Hermansen picked up the debris from the crash and left the scene. She then drove to another location and dropped the debris on the ground and contacted her supervisor informing him she was involved in an accident with a deer. The investigation and review of the MVR determined PO Hermansen was untruthful about the incident. As a result of the finding PO Hermansen resigned from the Tenafly Police Department.
