ORDINANCE NO. 25- 22 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TENAFLY, COUNTY OF BERGEN, VACATING AND REPURPOSING OF PORTIONS OF PIERMONT ROAD FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Tenafly, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on Monday, July 14, 2025, and will be further considered for final passage after public hearing at a meeting of the Mayor and Council on Monday, August 4, 2025 at 7:30 P.M. prevailing time, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

A clear and concise statement of this ordinance is to vacate the portion of Piermont Road between West Clinton Avenue and Hillside Avenue and the portion of Piermont Road between Hillside Avenue and Jay Street for the sole purpose of closing it to through traffic and to repurpose it for municipal purposes, including but not limited to municipal parking areas, event space, and community gathering areas as set forth in the ordinance.
