**NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE AND STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

**PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the foregoing ordinance was duly introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Tenafly, in the County of Bergen, New Jersey, held on August 4, 2025. Further notice is hereby given that (i) said ordinance appropriates \$100,000 for upgrades and repairs to the Little League Field with anticipation of a Local Recreation Improvement Grant (LRIG) from the Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$70,000 and a Bergen County Open Space grant totaling \$119,071, including accessories and all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto from the Open Space Recreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund.

(ii) will be considered for final passage and adoption, after public hearing thereon, at a regular meeting of said Borough Council to be held at 100 Riveredge Road, in said Borough on August 18, 2025 at 7:30 p.m.; and

## ORDINANCE NO. 25-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF TENAFLY, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$100,000, SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCES 24-09 AND 25-13 FOR UPGRADES AT THE LITTLE LEAGUE FIELD

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF TENAFLY, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY (NOT LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS OF all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** \$100,000 is hereby appropriated from the Municipal Open Space Recreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund to supplement Ordinances 24-09 and 25-13 (totaling \$625,000 inclusive of engineering costs of \$70,500) for upgrades and repairs to the Little League Field with anticipation of a Local Recreation Improvement Grant (LRIG) from the Department of Community Affairs in the amount of \$70,000 and a Bergen County Open Space grant totaling \$119,071, including accessories and all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto from the Open Space Recreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund.

**Section 2.** The capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
