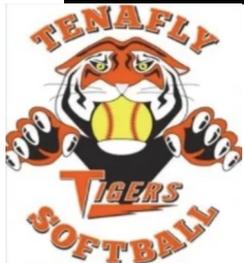

TRADITIONAL TAI CHI CHUAN & SWORD

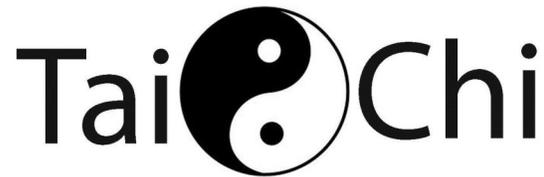
